Mr. Ambassador:

Pursuant to the Ministry of Justice's letter and the Civil Law Court's judgment in the cause of action brought before it in the interest of a naturalized Liberian citizen, Dr. Malichi Z. York, the Government of Liberia has consented to intervene, by and through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, by requesting the Government of the United States of America, through its Department of State to further the request of the matter in the interest of the Government of Liberia, and to seek the release of Dr. York as earlier directed, I am pleased to request your personal intervention in this important matter so as to ensure his timely release from detention and subsequent repatriation to Liberia, as a part of subsequent removal action by the Department of Homeland and Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).

In furtherance of this objective, you are further directed to intercede for and on behalf of the Government, and to negotiate the release of Dr. Malichi Z. York, in keeping with Diplomatic Note No. RL/MFA/3066/2-5/'06, which was sent to the United States Embassy near Monrovia; a copy of this note was given to you by the Minister of Foreign Affairs.

In order to expeditiously handle this matter, copies of the Ministry of Justice communication as well as the Mandate of the Sixth Judicial Circuit, Civil Law Court, Montserrado County, Republic of Liberia, Sitting in its June Term, A. D. 2006, to the Government of Liberia and Diplomatic Note No. RL/MFA/3066/2-5/'06, have been attached for your official attention and action.
